Kia ora koutou

The Level 4 rahui ends on Tuesday 28 April and New Zealand moves into Level 3 measures.

School at Level 3 is only for students who need to be school. This usually means the caregiver has returned to work and can not look after their child. Students can continue to do their school mahi from home if there is a caregiver or responsible adult at home.

On Tuesday, the school asked whānau for names of Year 7-10 students who needed to be at school on Wednesday 29 April. From the replies from whānau, the school has confirmed the students who are attending on Wednesday 29 April. Students who attend school from Wednesday will have to follow strict social distancing and hygiene guidelines.

If you also need to have your child in school, please email office@flaxcol.co.nz the student's name and the reason they need to attend. A school representative will contact you and confirm when you child can start back at school. To help plan for supervision, the school needs to know at least 24 hours before you want your child at school.

Please do not send your child to school on Wednesday unless you have contacted the school and the school has confirmed their attendance. If the student's attendance has not been confirmed, they will be sent home.

Distance learning will continue during Level 3. Teachers will be contacting students online or by phone to check their progress. More hardcopy packs of work will be distributed to junior students next week. For Year 7 to 10 students, the school has requested Ministry of Education devices for students who do not have a device.
